25	A. For purposes of this section, a gender neutral restroom means a toilet facility		

1	designed for use by no more than one person at a time that is a single stall restroom that is not		
2	restricted to a specific sex or gender identity by signage, design or installation of fixtures.		
3	B. A single stall restroom in any business or place of public accommodation, whether		
4	existing or proposed, shall be gender neutral.		
5	C. No later than, 2015 (sixty (60) days from the effective date of this		
6	Ordinance) existing businesses and places of public accommodation shall comply with this		
7	Subsection 23-9.1 SFCC 1987 by:		
8	(1) Replacing existing signs on the exterior of single stall restrooms depicting a		
9	single gender identity with signs indicating that the restrooms are gender neutral; and		
10	(2) Making the necessary improvements to make each single stall restroom

## **ORDINANCE NO. 20141211-211**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE TITLE 4 TO ADD A CHAPTER RELATING TO SIGNAGE FOR SINGLE-USER RESTROOMS; AND CREATING A PENALTY.

# BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. City Code Title 4 (Business Regulation and Permit Requirements) is amended to add a new Chapter 4-16 (Commercial Facilities) to read as follows:

## ARTICLE 1. GENDER-NEUTRAL SIGNAGE FOR SINGLE-USER RESTROOMS

## **§ 4-16-1 DEFINITIONS.**

- (1) GENDER NEUTRAL SIGNAGE means a sign that indicates a restroom without preference to a specific gender.
- (2) PRIVATE OR PRIVATE USE RESTROOM means plumbing fixtures in residences and apartments, private bathrooms in hotels and hospitals, and restrooms in commercial establishments where the fixtures are intended for the use of a family or an individual and are accessible only from a private room or office.
- (3) SINGLE-USER RESTROOM means a lockable restroom available for an individual for use with or without assistance.

# § 4-16-2 APPLICABILITY.

This article applies to single-user restrooms within commercial facilities that are not private or private use restrooms. This article is an additional requirement to those already required by the City Code.

# § 4-16-3 SIGNAGE REQUIRED.

- (A) A single-user restroom subject to this article must have gender-neutral signage.
- (B) A person with control over a commercial facility with at least one single-user restroom shall install and maintain gender-neutral signage for each single-user restroom.

# § 4-16-4 OFFENSE AND PENALTY.

- (A) A person who violates or fails to comply with a requirement of this article commits an offense.
- (B) An offense under this article is a Class C misdemeanor offense, punishable in accordance with Section 1-1-99 (Offenses; General Penalty).

PART 2. This ordinance takes effect on December 22, 2014.

#### ORDINANCE NO. 14-948

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST HOLLYWOOD ADDING CHAPTER 9.28.090 TO THE WEST HOLLYWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO GENDER NEUTRAL SINGLE STALL PUBLIC RESTROOMS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST HOLLYWOOD DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A new Section 9.28.090 is added to Chapter 9.28, Title 9, Article 3 of the West Hollywood Municipal Code to read as follows:

9.28.090 Public Accommodations—Gender Neutral Restrooms Required.

Any toilet facility designed for use by no more than one person at a time in any business or place of public accommodation ("single stall restrooms"), whether existing or proposed, shall not be restricted to a specific sex or gender identity by signage, design, or installation of fixtures.

SECTION 2. Existing businesses and places of public accommodation subject to Section 9.28.090 shall have sixty (60) days from the effective date of this ordinance to comply by replacing existing signs on the exterior of single stall restrooms depicting a single gender identity with signs indicating that they are gender neutral, and completing the necessary improvements to make each single stall restroom accessible to all gender identities. New businesses and places of public accommodation that have single stall restrooms shall provide the required signage and make each single stall restroom accessible to all gender identities immediately upon opening to the public.

SECTION 3. Signs consistent with this ordinance shall be compliant with the Building Code.
