Council Member John Aguilar, reported that a small business workshop will be held on Thursday, October 6, 2016, from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. This is a free event that will be held at CVEP's Office.

Council Member Shelley Kaplan, reported that he is on the CVAG Conservation Commission. In 2008 a 75 year conservation plan was implemented. At the time of implementation not all of the cities in the Valley opted to participate. As of the past few weeks all of the cities in the Valley are participating, which is a very good thing. He also reported that he represents Cathedral City on the Mosquito and Vector Control Board. Notification has been given that there are some mosquitos in the City that transmit the zica virus. Vector Contol is moving their focus to the westside of the City to address the issue. Residents that will be affected will be notified.

Mayor Stan Henry, announced that the Cathedral City High School Choir will be competing in Hawaii in Spring of next year. They are looking for sponsorships to help fund the trip for the students. He reported that he and Council Member Aguilar participated in the City Hall at Your Corner, which was held at the Catherdral City Library. There was great conversation and it's always a good opportunity to talk to residents. He attended the Desert Valley Builder's Association Luncheon, the United Way Luncheon, where the City will be receiving an award for being the Silver Dersert Cup winners, and on Friday he will be speaking at the Woman's Realtor Luncheon.
